

- Internal Quality organization to stimulate development of internal quality culture – and not just compliance






Internal Quality Assurance Focus and Principles

- Assurance + Development
- Establishing thresholds/standards for performance => Use data to identify and act on performance problems
- Use internal and external feedback and dialogue to take stock of the programme => Plan new initiatives to develop the programme further



Internal Quality Assurance Focus and principles


- Systematic Quality circle logic

- 3) Monitor / Collect data

- 5) Discuss needed changes/interventions
